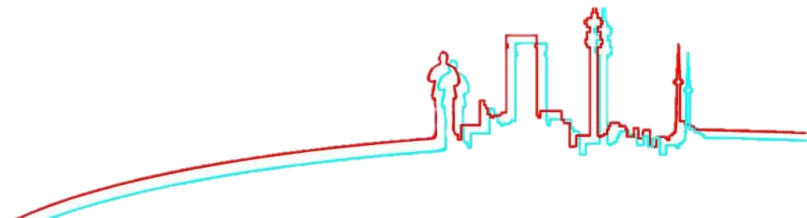


Attraction	Description and comment	Time
Apartheid Museum	<p>Start your day by visiting Apartheid Museum. A visit to this renowned museum is second to none in exemplifying the rise and fall of apartheid, it narrates a touching story of the triumph of the human spirit over adversity, beginning in 1948 right through to the liberation in 1994 when Nelson Mandela was elected president of the republic. 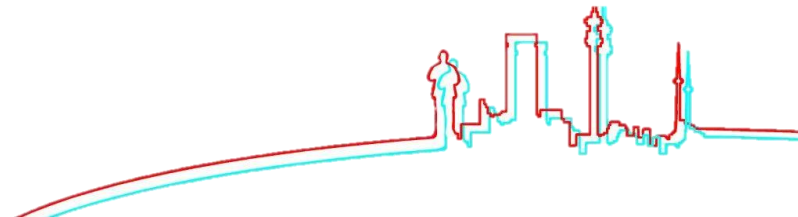

Vilakazi Street	Vilakazi Street is the only street in the world where once two Nobel Peace Prize laureates lived. Today, Nelson Mandela's house is a museum, while Archbishop Desmond Tutu still maintains his residence	Minimum 2 hours depending on visitors time
Gold Reef City	<p>Escape to great entertainment in the heart of Jozi south. The casino complex is constantly alive with excitement and energy. 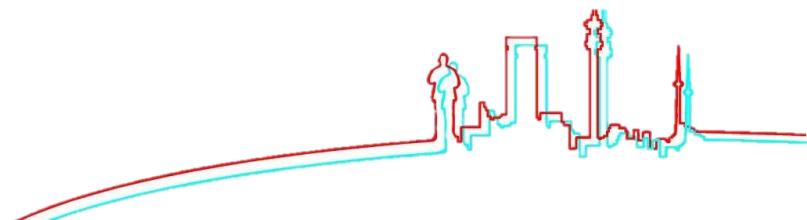


Attraction	Description and comment	Time
Lebo's Backpackers Soweto	Visit Lebo's Soweto Backpackers for Tuk-Tuk Tour/Bicycle Tours. A shorter tour of Soweto that will take you to some of the most interesting historical sites around Soweto which includes Nelson Mandela House. Visit the formal migrant workers' hostel and be introduced to conditions of male mine workers and meet the families that live here today. Cycle/Tu-Tuk through the vibrant community of Meadowlands, and continue to the Hector Pieteron Memorial, historical landmark of the 1976 student uprising.	2 hours



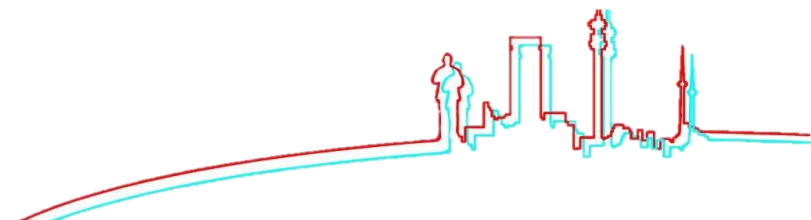


Attraction	Description and comment	Time
Constitution Hill	<p>Constitution Hill is a living museum that tells the story of South Africa's journey to democracy. The site is a former prison and military fort that bears testament to South Africa's turbulent past and, today, is home to the country's Constitutional Court, which endorses the rights of all citizens.</p>	<p>Minimum 1 hour depending on visitors time.</p>



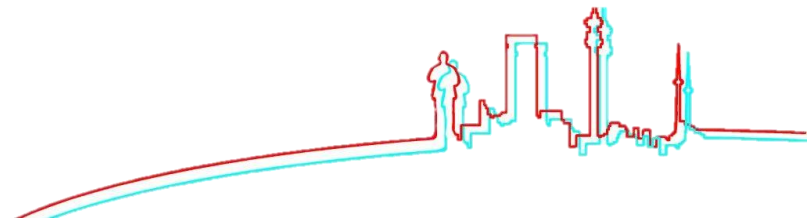

<p>Maboneng Precinct</p>	<p>Maboneng, is a seSotho word meaning “place of light”, a fitting name for a district that has fast become a centre of creative energy for Johannesburg’s urban artists. 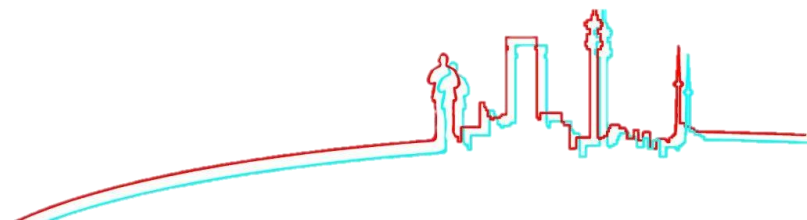


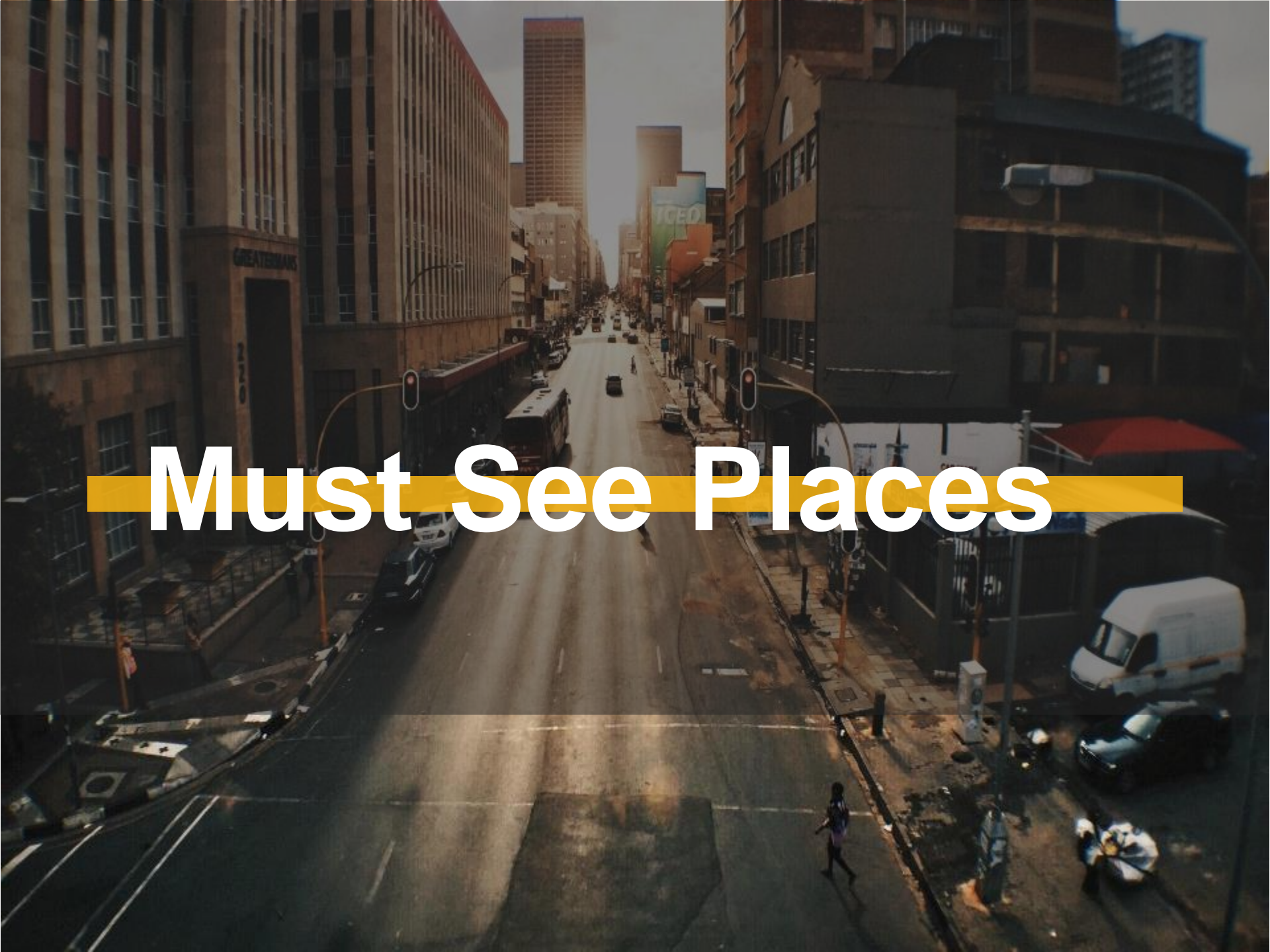
Attraction	Description and comment	Time
Walter Sisulu National Botanical Gardens	This Botanical Garden was founded in 1982, but has been a popular venue for outings since the 1800's. The Garden has been voted the best place to get back to nature in Gauteng for 9 years in a row.	Minimum 2 hours depending on visitors time.

Origins Centre	Visitors to the Origins Centre follow a path of hominin innovation that began over 2 million years ago. The museum delves into the fascinating beliefs of the San. It contains evidence of ancient stone tools, artefacts of symbolic and spiritual significance, and examples of the region's visually striking rock art. It also captures the impact of the colonial front and highlights examples of resistance.	Minimum 1 hour depending on visitors time
